Torch Red, Black, Elkhart Blue, Arctic White, Ceramic Matrix Gray Metallic, Hypersonic Gray, Rapid Blue, Silver Flare Metallic, Caffeine Metallic, Accelerate Yellow, Red Mist Metallic Tintcoat. GM has a fix for the C8 Corvette transmission Control Module Communication Loss. The problem: Transmission Control Module may detect loss of communication. The Hazards: While the issue does not pose a safety hazard. The problem could prevent the transmission form producing DTC's or an MIL if something more serious were wrong with the unit. The Fix: This problem can be remedied via an over the air software update. Owner can also have their vehicle serviced at a GM dealer to receive the software updates. Chevy moves a 95 year old World War II vet to the front of the Corvette waitlist. This feel good story with all the demand for the mid-engine C8 and the UAW strike followed by the COVID-19 pandemic and semiconductor storage. Meet Bobbie Carson-95 year old Corvette enthusiast who's owned seven Bow Tie sports car throughout his life time. He is also a World War II veteran now own his eight corvette, a 2022 Arctic White Stingray that was delivered to him at the National Corvette Museum just 30 days after he order it.






Team Corvette Members dining at the Blackstone Smokehouse. Excellent food and service. Out the rear exit, yes we paid, and a short walk to the Capitol.




