


In or Out is again working off and on??? We have more events coming up, be sure to check your email frequently to stay on top of current and future events.

# July 28th Bay City MI for Rock the Boat. Dinner, Cruise and MUSIC!!




This has been a fun event the last two years. Jim Schoenfield has reserved a block of rooms at the Double Tree Motel in Bay City. Short walk to dock.
