Old Business: Appreciation dinner thoughts? Lower turnout, cost, less vehicles cruising on Saginaw Street.


Second round of nominations at the membership meeting next week.

Team Corvette is a Michigan based Corvette club with numerous interests. We have fun with our cars and members. We do day cruises and some out of town events.


We are primarily a social club and try to hold events year round in addition to our monthly membership meetings.
