

### National Corvette Museum (NCM) Ambassador

As the Ambassador for the National Corvette Museum (NCM) for Team Corvette, I'm pleased to share a brief update on the closing of the current model year and a look ahead to what's coming in 2026 for the venerable Chevrolet Corvette.

Wrapping Up the 2025 Model Year

- The production schedule for the 2025 model year has been clearly defined: ordering for many 2025 Corvettes closed in late May, with production scheduled to end on August 1 of 2025.
- Through our R8C Museum-Delivery program, the Museum achieved a milestone: the 20,000th Corvette delivered via this program was a 2026 Corvette Stingray in Sebring Orange.
- From a museum perspective, we're also focused on preserving Corvette heritage, for example, kicking off the construction of a new 66,000 sqft collections facility set to open in fall 2026, which reflects the commitment to the past even as new models arrive.

For our visitors and Corvette community, that means one last chance in 2025 to experience the current-generation finishes, colors, and options before the next wave of updates kicks in.

The 2026 Corvette lineup brings several significant enhancements and models that Corvette enthusiasts should note:

- The exciting top-end model, the 2026 Chevrolet Corvette ZR1X, has debuted packing up to 1,250 horsepower via a hybrid electrified all-wheel drive system and built right here in Bowling Green.
- Production for 2026 models is slated to begin August 4, 2025 (shortly after the 2025 run ends).
- Early production data shows volume ramping up: for example, nearly 200 units of the 2026 ZR1 have reportedly been completed, a significant increase over 2025's start-up.
- Beyond powertrain and performance upgrades, expect interior enhancements—including larger digital displays, updated cockpit layouts, and new color options for both exterior and interior.

For Museum members and visitors, the arrival of the 2026 models means fresh opportunities: new display pieces, updated technology spotlight tours, and perhaps new behind-the-scenes access tied to our upcoming Collections facility.
