# National Corvette Museum (NCM) Ambassador

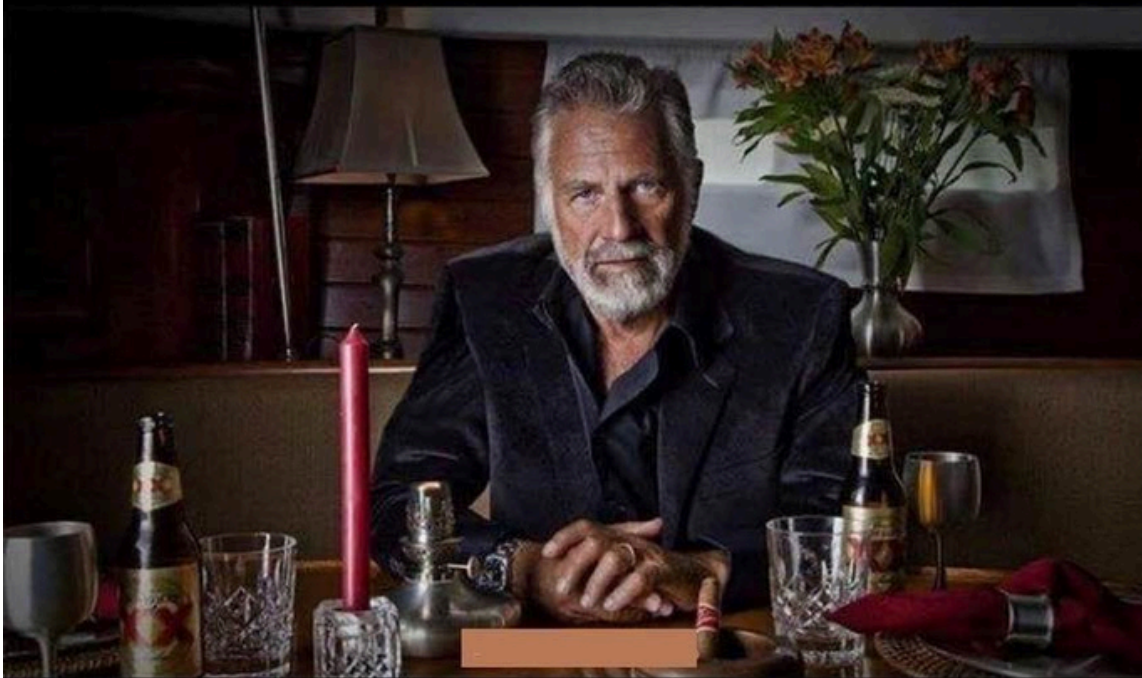
The 2027 Corvette is adding the Grand Sport and Grand Sport X to the model lineup.

The GS and GSX will be a wide body with the LS6 engine which is a 6.7L V8 (535 HP / 520 TQ). The GSX will replace the E-Ray as the All-Wheel Drive hybrid and have 720 HP / 665 TQ. The 2027 Stingray will also have the LS6 engine.

There will be 2 new exterior colors, Admiral Blue Metallic and Pitch Gray Metallic. Two exterior colors will be discontinued, Riptide Blue Metallic and Hysteria Purple Metallic.

The MSRP for the base 1LT of these models will be as follows: Stingray - \$73,495, Grand Sport - \$88,495 and Grand Sport X - \$112,195.
